

# Time for College?

If your student will attend college this fall, your GET units can help pay the bills.



## It's easy to use your GET units...

- Go to [www.get.wa.gov](http://www.get.wa.gov) and click on the **“My GET Account”** icon at the top of the screen.
- Log in to your account.  
If you've forgotten your Login ID and PIN, just call us.
- Select **“Use Your GET Units.”**
- Follow the three easy steps.

## KEY DATES

**By July 1** Tell us where your student is going to college by completing an Intent to Enroll as soon as possible. Most colleges prefer to know by this date.

**After August 1** Review your account and tell us how you would like to pay for college by completing a Direct Payment or Reimbursement Request. Your account will show the number and value of units eligible for use in the 2009-2010 academic year.

# Using your GET units

## Important Reminders

- As the account owner, you must initiate all direct payments and/or reimbursements from your account.
- Before you complete a direct payment request, please contact the college's student accounts office to verify the exact cost of tuition or room and board.
  - If you request too much money, the college could issue a refund, which may have tax consequences. (If the college notifies us, we may be able to reduce the requested amount to avoid an overpayment.)
  - If you request too little money, you could pay late fees or your student could be dropped from classes.
- If your student will attend a Washington community or technical college, he should notify the registrar's office that he has eligible GET units when he registers for classes.
- Please allow **at least two weeks** for us to send a direct payment to your student's college. It's your responsibility to allow enough time for your payment to reach the college.
